




Simplify cannulation.





The Beacon Tip Van Schie Seeking Catheter is used to ease navigation during the catheterization of bifurcated endoluminal AAA stent grafts. Different available tip designs allow the Beacon Tip Van Schie to simplify cannulation within iliacs of varying size and tortuosity.

Compatibility

The Beacon tips have five different configurations from which to choose, each sold separately. The Van Schie catheter accommodates a .035 inch wire guide and comes standard in 5 Fr with a length of 65 cm.

Visibility & Durability

The radiopaque Beacon tips enhance visualization during cannulation. Their nylon-braided construction provides torque control, as well as enhanced flexibility and durability.
