The result is the Acrobat, which has, quantifiably, one of the most flexible tips on the GI market. The tip is so flexible, in fact, that it required the least amount of gram-force to create an alpha loop 1 cm from the distal tip as compared to other GI wire guides.

And it is the only wire guide with a calibrated, spring-coil tip design to give clinicians the flexibility and pushability needed for initial cannulation and/or traversing difficult strictures, attributes, which are essential to supporting successful patient outcomes.
